Vergissmeinnicht




Vergissmeinnicht (German for forget-me-not) is a symmetric shawl that is knitted top-down. It is designed for solid or hand-dyed semi-solid yarn. The shawl's body is worked in garter stitch. It is easy to knit. In the end a beautiful and easy to work lace border is formed.

Finished Measurements

The finished shawl measures
40 cm (16") x 170 cm (67")



Yarn

Two skeins of sport or fingering weight yarn with 310 to 400 m per 100 g, 200 g in total.

It is easily possible to use a thinner or thicker yarn. You can adjust the measurements of the shawl, too. Have fun!

Yarn Suggestions

- Zauberwiese – Merino Superwash Sport
- Rohrspatz & Wollmeise - Pure
- dibadu – Twisted Fifties
- Zitron – Lifestyle
- das Mondschaft – Aurora

Color

I used a hand-dyed semi-solid yarn of green color.

Needles & Notions

- One 80 cm (32") circular knitting needle in size **3,5 mm** (US 4)
- Tapestry needle
- Blocking pins and / or blocking wire

Gauge

Gauge is not critical. As mentioned before you can also use thinner yarn.

25 st x 45 rows (garter stitch)



Abbreviations

k	knit
p	purl
st	stitch(es)
yo	yarn over
yo2	yarn over twice (2 loops on the needle)
k2tog	knit 2 st together to decrease 1 st; insert right needle into 2 st at the same time and knit;
sl1k	slip one st as if to knit to the other needle;
pssso	pass slipped st over the knitted one
CO	cast on
BO	bind off
* ... *	pattern repeat

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Instructions

Set-up

CO 6 stitches.

Row 1: k1, yo, k4, yo, k1;

Row 2: k all st;

Row 3: k1, yo, k6, yo, k1;

Row 4: k all st;

Row 5: k2, yo2, k1, yo, k to last 3 st, yo, k1, yo2, k2;

Row 6: k all st (k into yo2 only 1 time, dropping the other loop from your needle);

You have 14 st on your needles.

Body Pattern

Row 1: k2, yo2, *k1, yo* (2 times), k until 4 st left, *yo, k1* (2 times), yo2, k2;

Row 2: k all st (k into yo2 only 1 time, dropping the other loop from your needle);

Repeat row 1 – 2 until you have 356 st on the needles. Then knit the leaf border pattern.

For a different size you can adapt the stitch count: you will need a number of stitches, that can be divided by 22 remainder 4, for example 290 st for a smaller version.



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Lace Pattern

Row 1: k2 *yo, k5, sl1k, k1, pssso, k5, k2tog, k5, yo, k3* (repeat to 2 st), k2;

Row 2 and all even rows: k2, p to 2 st, k2;

Row 3: k2, *k1, yo, k5, sl1k, k1, pssso, k3, k2tog, k5, yo, k4* (repeat to 2 st), k2;


Row 5: k2, *k2, yo, k5, sl1k, k1, pssso, k1, k2tog, k5, yo, k5* (repeat to 2 st), k2;

Row 7: k2, *k3, yo, k5, sl1k, k1, pssso, k5, k2tog, k5, yo* (repeat to 2 st), k2;

Row 9: k2, *k4, yo, k5, sl1k, k1, pssso, k3, k2tog, k5, yo, k1* (repeat to 2 st), k2;

Row 11: k2, *k5, yo, k5, sl1k, k1, pssso, k1, k2tog, k5, yo, k2* (repeat to 2 st), k2;

Repeat row 1-12 for 3 more times.



- k
- edge stitch
- yo
- sl1k, k, pssso
- k2tog

Ending

Row1: k all st.

Row2: k all st.

Repeat row 1-2 for 2 more times.

BO all st loosely.

Finishing

Weave in all ends, wash and block shawl to finished measurements.
